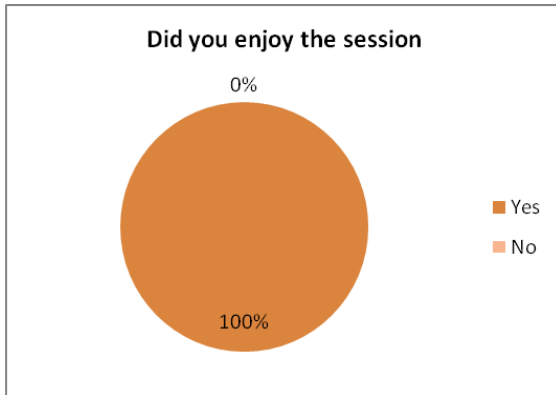

*"There was not really a part - I loved it all"*

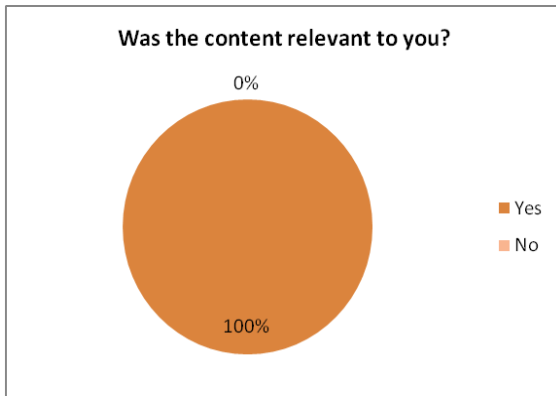

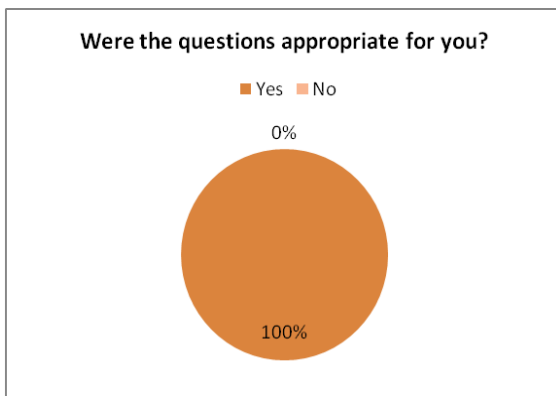

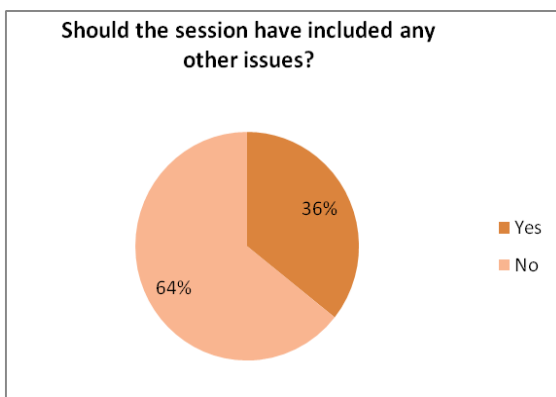
**2. Was the content relevant to you?**

*"Our own way of thinking"*

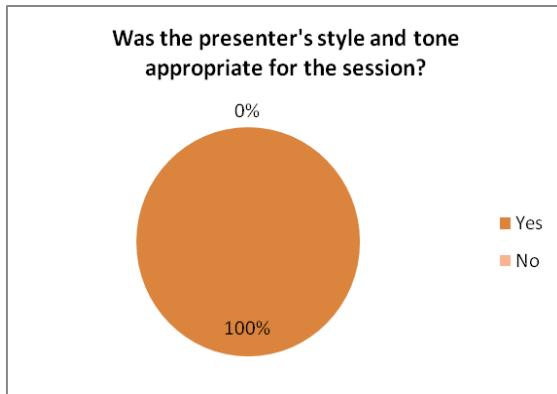
*"I think a sensible person would expand more on anything not said"*

*"More activities and a chance for everyone to answer at least one question"*

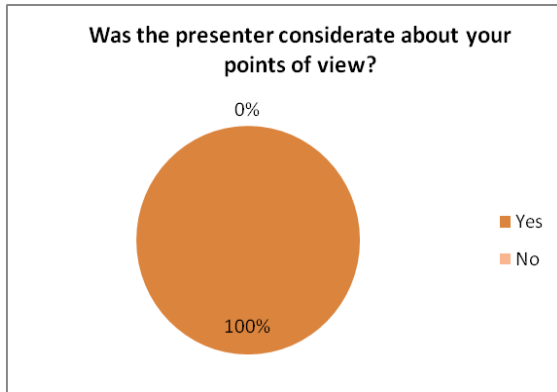
*"If a child has been brought up in a good way, would he/she still do disrespectful things?"*

## Delivery

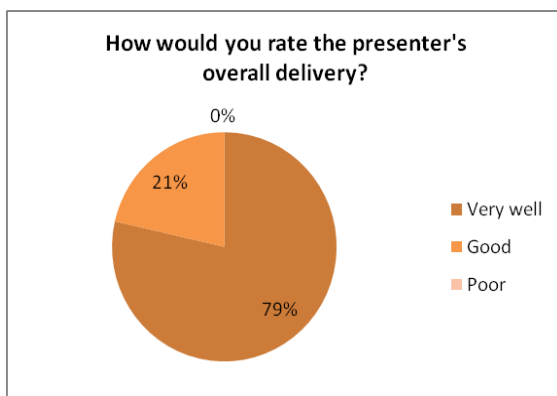
### 1. Was the presenter's style and tone appropriate for the session?
