Overview

- This report is a compilation of feedback from all the *Shaping Attitudes for workplace* sessions run so far with over 200 young people.
- *Shaping Attitudes* is aimed at 16-19 year olds preparing for work placements/internships and apprenticeships; improving their employability skills - addressing attitudes in *Relationships* and *Behaviour*.
- The section on *Relationships* looks in depth at Interaction, Challenges and Teamwork; while the *Behaviour* section covers issues such as Ethics, Risks, Time-keeping, Diversity and other related issues.
- Clients so far include: London East Connexions Partnership, George Monoux College, Highbury College (Portsmouth), FutureVersity (pilot test), Southwark College, Lewisham College, The Charter School and WhiteBox Digital.

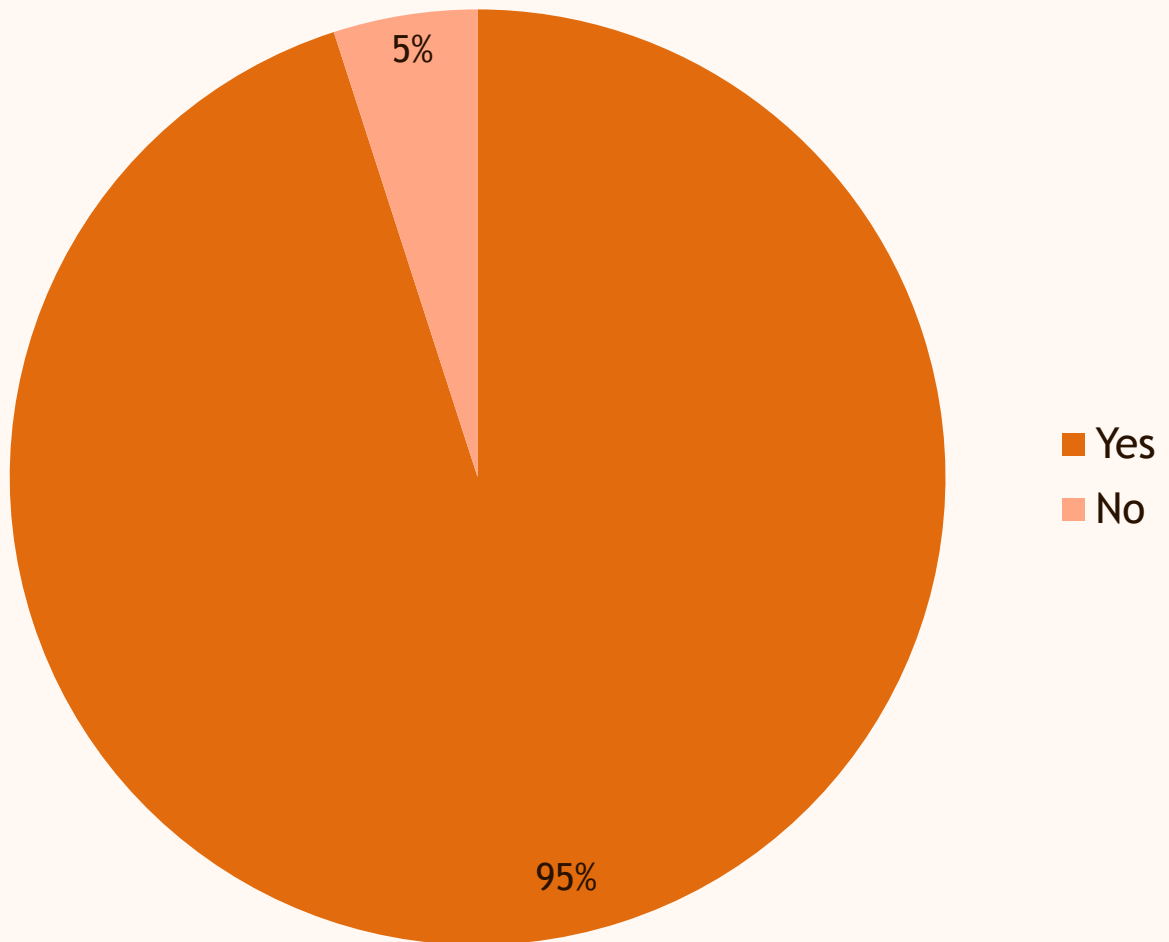

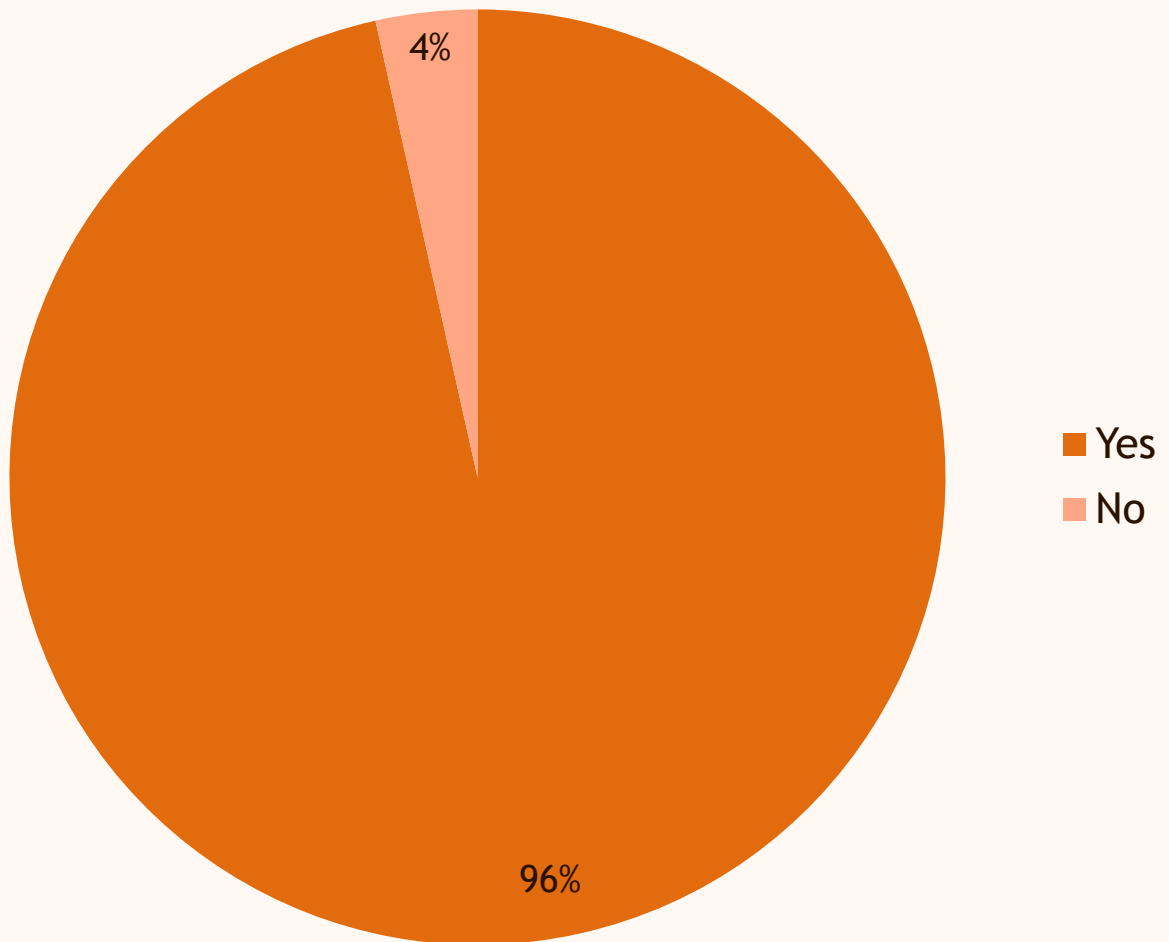
“I found the presentation very useful as it got me thinking about what I wanted to do”

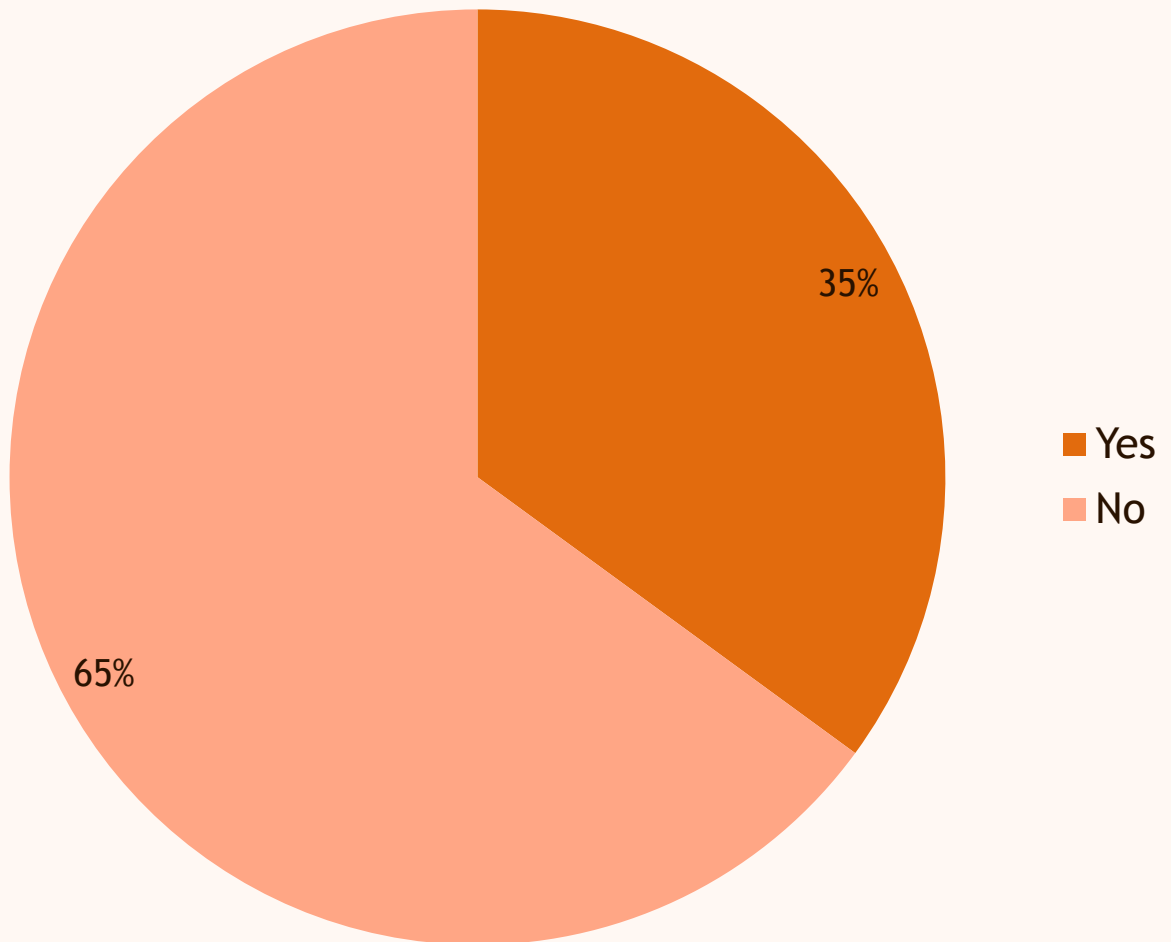

Were the issues important for you to know?



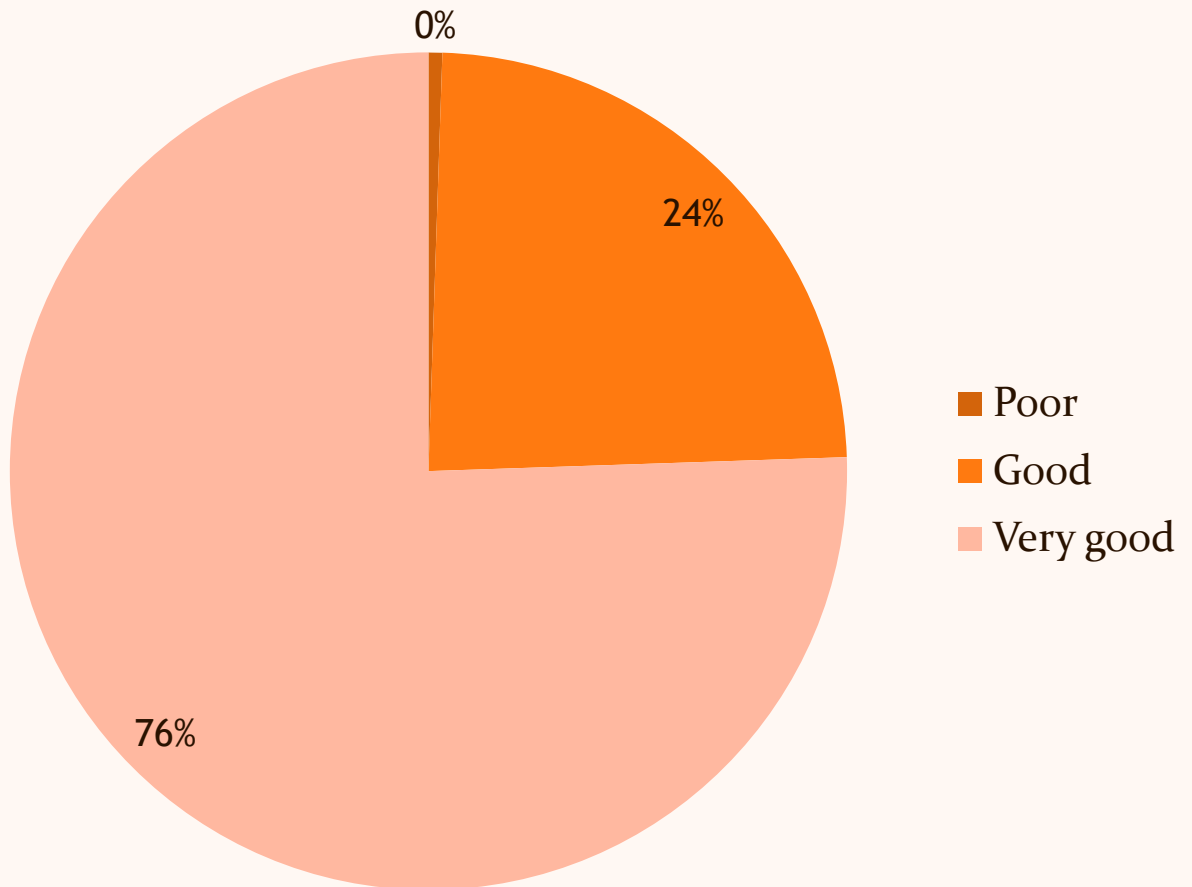
Should the programme include other issues?



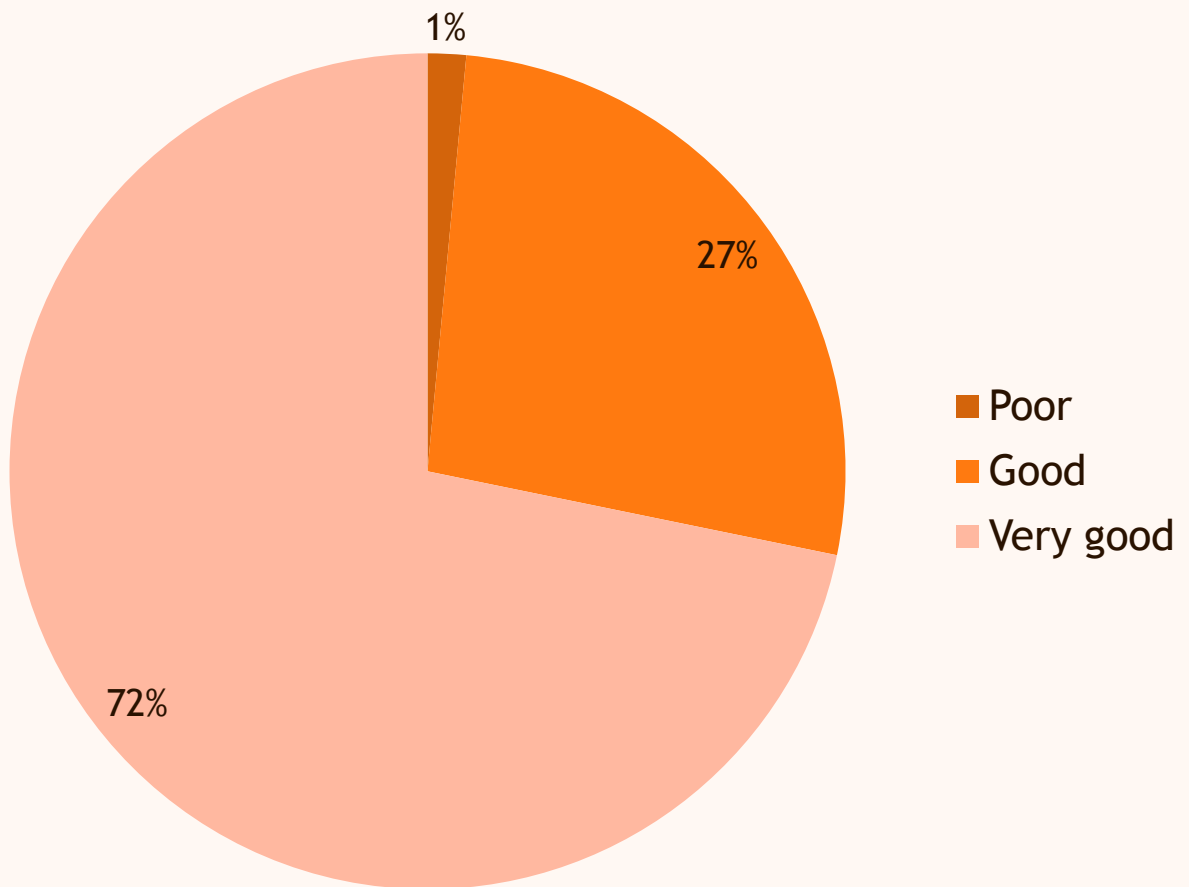

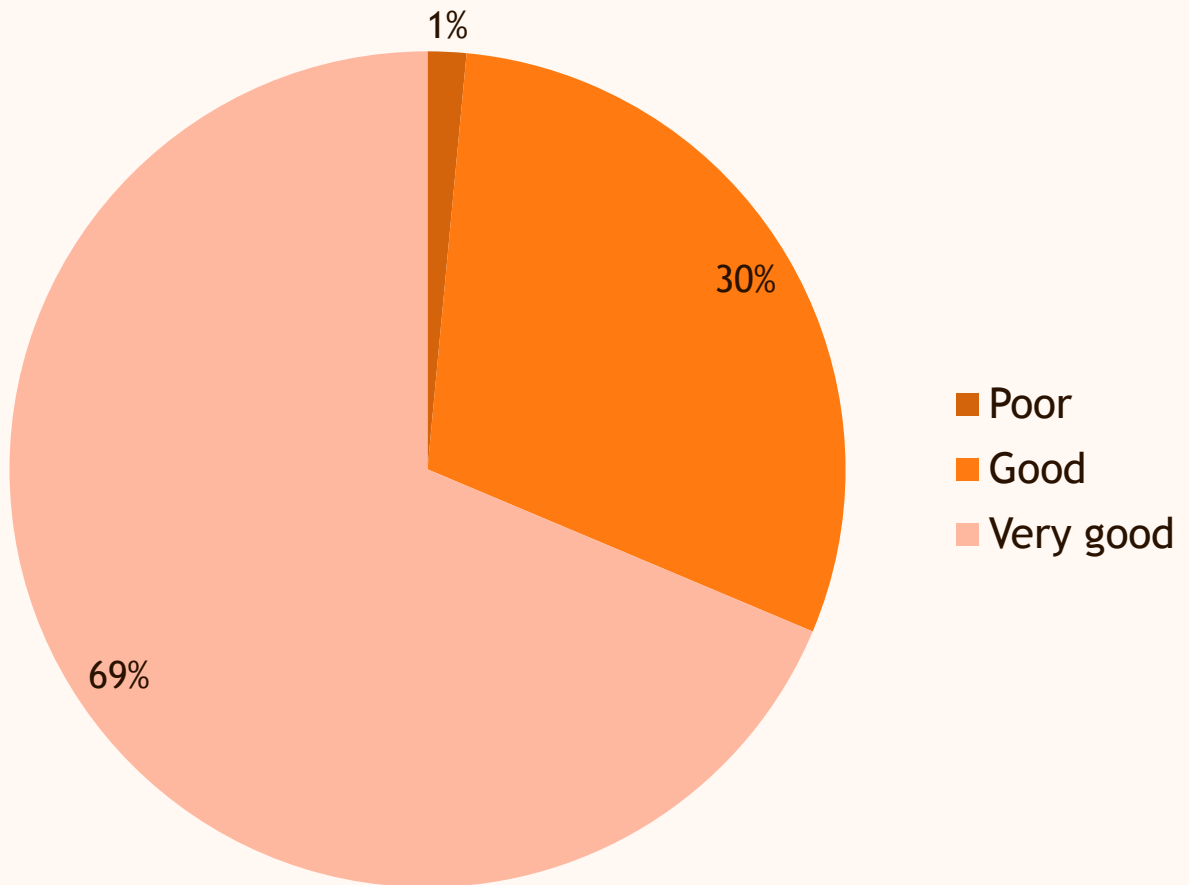

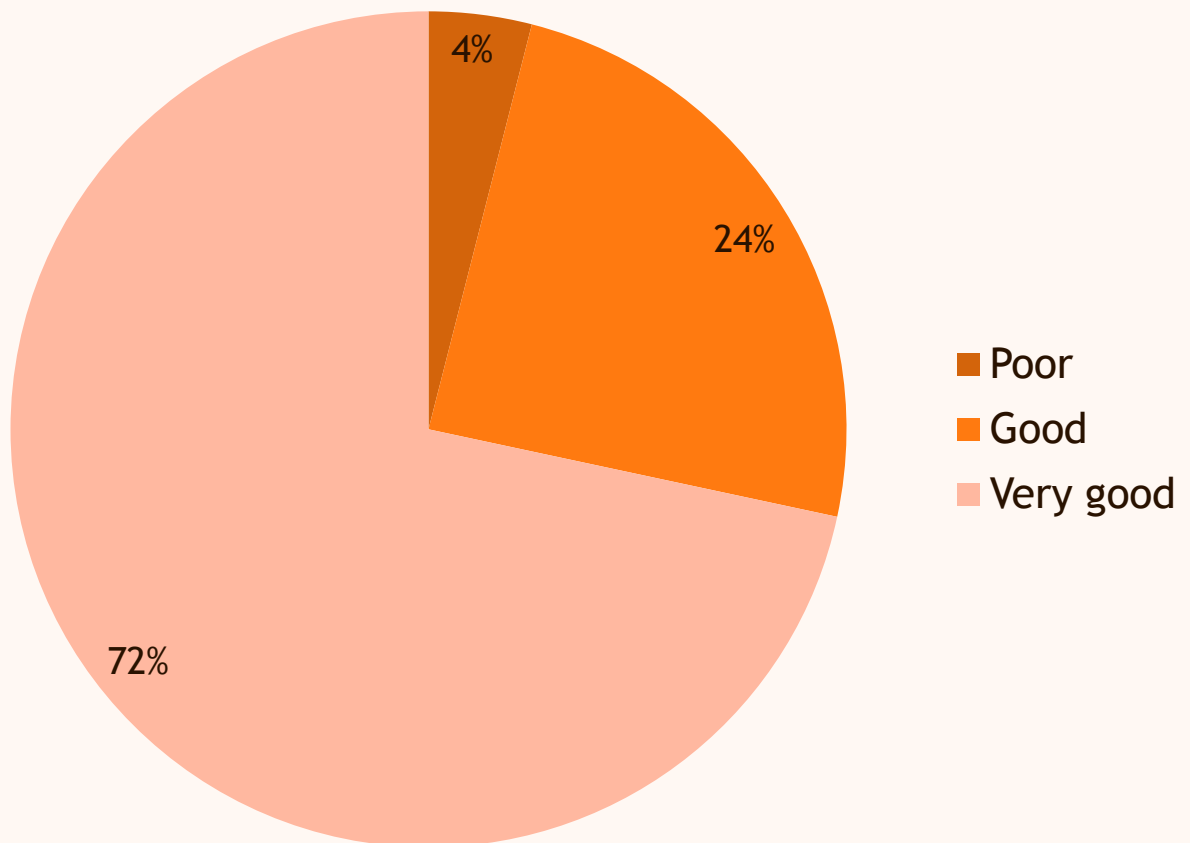
